Applications are being accepted for the position of Director of Applications at the Department of Information Technology Services. This position is allocated to the competitive class. The nature of the appointment is provisional pending outcome of a Civil Service Examination. Examination will be announced at a later date.

This is a managerial and technical position responsible for the short- and long-range planning for the development and support of the County-wide information technology application systems. The work involves responsibility for coordinating, scheduling, and supervising all application programming and support activities within the Information Technology Services Department. The employee is responsible for creative solutions to meet user and application requirements through software development and/or software acquisition and support.

MINIMUM QUALIFICATIONS: Either:

- A. Master's Degree* and two (2) years of professional or military level experience in programming or systems analysis, which shall have included one (1) year of supervisory experience or one (1) year of supervisory experience in any field; Or
- B. Bachelor's Degree*, and four (4) years of experience as defined in (A) above, which shall have included three (3) years of supervisory experience or three (3) years of supervisory experience in any field OR
- C. Associates Degree* and six (6) years of experience as defined in (A) above, which shall have included three (3) years of supervisory experience or three (3) years of supervisory experience in any field ; OR

SPECIAL REQUIREMENTS: Posses and maintain a valid driver's license.

Note: Your degree or credits must have been awarded by a college or university accredited by a regional, national, or specialized agency recognized as an accrediting agency by the U.S. Department of Education/U.S. Secretary of Education. If your degree or credits were awarded by an educational institution outside the United States and its territories, you must provide independent verification of equivalency.
