The Department of Planning is accepting applications for the position of Senior Planner. This position is allocated to the competitive class. The nature of this appointment is provisional, pending the outcome of a Civil Service Examination. Civil Service Examination will be announced at a later date. This is professional level work involving responsibility for conducting studies, formulating plans and managing specialized County programs. The work involves consulting with appropriate officials and boards and the preparation of reports for use in the preparation of the County's Comprehensive Development Plan. Work is performed under general supervision with latitude allowed for the exercise of independent judgment in performance of all phases of work assignments. Supervision is exercised over assigned staff. Does related work as required.

MINIMUM QUALIFICATIONS: Either:

- A) Graduation from a regionally accredited college or university or one accredited by the New York State Board of Regents to grant degrees with a Master's Degree in Community, Regional, Urban or City Planning and one (1) year of experience in municipal, county or regional planning; OR
- B) Graduation from a regionally accredited college or university or one accredited by the New York State Board of Regents to grant degrees with a Master's Degree in Architecture, Civil Engineering, Environmental Studies, Geographic Information Systems, Geography, Government, Historic Preservation, Landscape Architecture, Public Administration or related field and eighteen (18) months of experience in municipal, county or regional planning; OR
- C) Graduation from a regionally accredited college or university or one accredited by the New York State Board of Regents to grant degrees with a Bachelor's Degree in Community, Regional, Urban or City Planning, Architecture, Civil Engineering, Environmental Studies, Geographic Information Systems, Geography, Government, Historic Preservation, Landscape Architecture, Public Administration or related field and four (4) years of experience as defined in (B) above.

NOTE: Your degree must have been awarded by a college or university accredited by a regional, national, or specialized agency recognized as an accrediting agency by the U.S. Department of Education/U.S. Secretary of Education. If your degree was awarded by an educational institution outside the United States and its territories, you must provide independent verification of equivalency.
