VACANCY ANNOUNCEMENT

DEPARTMENT OF HEALTH GRADE 13 Public Health Sanitarian

Applications are now being accepted by the Department of Health to fill the Public Health Sanitarian vacancy. This position is allocated to the competitive class. The nature of the appointment is temporary substitute. Once the permanent holder attains status in another position, this position will become provisional pending the outcome of a Civil Service Exam. Civil Service Examination will be announced at a later date.

This is specialized professional work monitoring a variety of programs of an investigative nature, for conformity with State and County Sanitation codes, including on-site inspections, interpretation of laboratory results, preparation of reports and recommendations, and testifying at enforcement proceedings. Work is performed under the general supervision of a higher-level public health sanitarian and working supervision may be exercised over Public Health Technicians and trainees. Incumbents may be required to work evenings and/or weekends. Does related work as required.

MINIMUM QUALIFICATIONS: Either:

- (A) Bachelor's Degree with 30 credit hours in the natural sciences, of which not more than twelve (12) credit hours may be in the applied sciences, and must satisfactorily complete a Public Health training course approved by the New York State Health Department within two years of appointment; OR
- (B) Five (5) years experience as a Public Health Technician and satisfactory completion of a Public Health training course approved by the New York State Health Department.

SPECIAL REQUIREMENT: Incumbents must possess and maintain a valid driver's license.

NOTE: The term natural science shall mean a science such as biology, chemistry or physics that deals with the objects, phenomena, or laws of nature and the physical world. It shall include all physical and biological sciences.

The term applied science shall mean science based courses in environmental technology, sanitation technology, medical technology, public health, infection control or food science.

NOTE: Your degree or credits must have been awarded by a college or university accredited by a regional, national, or specialized agency recognized as an accrediting agency by the U.S. Department of Education/U.S. Secretary of Education. If your degree or credits were awarded by an educational institution outside the United States and its territories, you must provide independent verification of equivalency.
