## **VACANCY ANNOUNCEMENT**

### **Director of Park Construction and Maintenance GRADE 17**

### **ORANGE COUNTY DEPARTMENT OF PARKS, RECREATION, AND CONSERVATION**

The Orange County Department of Parks, Recreation, and Conservation is now accepting applications for the position of Director of Park Construction and Maintenance. This position is allocated to the competitive class. The nature of the appointment is provisional, pending the outcome of a Civil Service Examination. Civil Service Examination will be announced at a later date.

This administrative and supervisory position is responsible for all construction and maintenance activities within the Orange County Parks system. Position is responsible for the supervision and coordination of all projects being undertaken by the Park Maintenance Supervisor, Horticultural Supervisor, and the Golf Course Superintendents. Incumbent also has direct input in the policy making, personnel decisions, safe operation of all facilities, decision making for the upgrading of existing areas and the planning and design of new work. Work is performed under the general direction of the Commissioner of Parks, Recreation and Conservation. Does related work as required.

#### **MINIMUM QUALIFICATIONS:**

- (A) Associate's degree or higher, in Engineering Science, Construction Technology, or related field and six (6) years of experience in construction and/or maintenance work, three (3) of which shall have been in a supervisory capacity; OR
- (B) Graduation from high school or possession of a high school equivalency diploma and eight (8) years of experience as defined in (A) above.

Note: Your degree must have been awarded by a college or university accredited by a regional, national, or specialized agency recognized as an accrediting agency by the U.S. Department of Education/U.S. Secretary of Education. If your degree was awarded by an educational institution outside the United States and its territories, you must provide independent verification of equivalency. For new employees - \$47.6972 per hour; \$99,210.18 annually (40- hour work week)
