Applications are now being accepted for Per Diem Stationary Engineers. The work involves responsibility for the operation and maintenance of heating, air-conditioning, hot water systems and emergency generators at the Department of Residential Health Care Services. The work also involves responsibility for installing, repairing, and replacing hot water and cold water lines throughout the facility, including the water and sewer plants. Work is performed under the general supervision of the Maintenance Mechanic Supervisor. Employees may be required to work weekends or holidays.

MINIMUM QUALIFICATIONS: Graduation from high school or completion of a high school equivalency diploma and three (3) years of experience in the operation and maintenance of commercial heating and central air conditioning equipment.

NOTSE:

- Education beyond high school at an accredited college, technical/trade school or the Armed Forces in a degree/program concentration in heating, air-conditioning and/or refrigeration may be substituted for up to two (2) years of the required experience on a year for year basis.
