The incumbent is serving in this position under approval pursuant to Section 211 of the Retirement and Social Security Law. In order to determine if there is sufficient basis for a new request for the incumbent, Orange County is conducting a public inquiry as to the availability of qualified non-retired persons for recruitment.

This is a technical and administrative position involving responsibility for the day-to-day administration and operation of the County's Emergency Management Office, directing operations in the event of a natural disaster or civil defense emergency. The Deputy provides support to the Commissioner by handling the day-to-day issues relative to the operations of the emergency management division. General supervision is exercised over subordinates, including volunteers participating in programs or activities. The Deputy acts for and in place of the Commissioner in his/her absence. The Deputy is appointed by and serves at the pleasure of the Commissioner.

Suggested Standards: Bachelor's or Associate's Degree and three to seven (3-7) years of work experience in an emergency management environment.

Salary range: \$76,098 - \$144,220 depending on experience.
