VACANCY ANNOUNCEMENT

SKILLED LABORER GRADE 08

ORANGE COUNTY DEPARTMENT OF PARKS, RECREATION, AND CONSERVATION

The Orange County Department of Parks, Recreation, and Conservation is now accepting applications for the position of Skilled Laborer. This position can be assigned to any of our park locations. The nature of the appointment is temporary substitute. Once the permanent holder attains status in another position, this position will become permanent, subject to a probationary term. This is a very broad class covering different types of work. Employees in this class work at one or more of a number of laboring tasks where a specific skill or prior experience is essential. This work is in addition to the performance of routine manual labor. Supervision may be exercised over a small number of subordinate employees. The work is performed under general supervision with latitude for independent decision-making. Incumbent may be required to work evenings, weekends, and holidays. Does related work as required.

MINIMUM QUALIFICATION: Either:

- (A) Completion of thirty (30) credits* or certificate in Building Construction, Electrical Construction & Maintenance, Heating & Plumbing Service, Turf & Grounds Care Management, Landscape Development, Automotive Mechanics, any of the building trades, or related field, and one (1) year of work experience in any of the building trades; OR
- (B) Graduation from high school or possession of a high school equivalency diploma and possession of a certificate of completion from a vocational/technical school program in construction, welding, pre-engineering or engineering, turf maintenance, landscaping, any of the building trades, or related field and two (2) years of work experience as defined in (A) above; OR
- (C) Graduation from high school or possession of a high school equivalency diploma and three (3) years of experience as defined in (A) above.

SPECIAL REQUIREMENT: Must possess and maintain a valid driver's license.

***NOTE:** Your credits must have been awarded by a college or university accredited by a regional, national, or specialized agency recognized as an accrediting agency by the U.S. Department of Education/U.S. Secretary of Education. If your credits were awarded by an educational institution outside the United States and its territories, you must provide independent verification of equivalency.
