VACANCY ANNOUNCEMENT

ORANGE COUNTY DEPARTMENT OF CONSUMER AFFAIRS INSPECTOR OF WEIGHTS AND MEASURES GRADE 9

The Orange County Department of Consumer Affairs is now accepting applications to fill the position of Inspector of Weights and Measures. This position is allocated to the competitive class. The nature of the appointment is provisional, pending the outcome of a Civil Service Examination. Civil Service Examination will be announced at a later date. This is inspection work involving testing, weighing and measuring devices in an assigned area to ensure compliance with established laws and standards. Works under the supervision of the Commissioner of Consumer Affairs who gives general instructions and assignments and spot checks work for effective compliance with the law. Does related work as required.

MINIMUM QUALIFICATIONS: Either:

- (A) Graduation from a regionally accredited college or university or one accredited by the New York State Board of Regents to grant degrees with an Associate's Degree; OR
- (B) Graduation from high school or possession of a high school equivalency diploma and two (2) years of experience involving inspection, repair or use of weighing or measuring devices, which includes calibration.

SPECIAL REQUIREMENT: Possess and maintain a valid driver's license.

Note: Your degree or credits must have been awarded by a college or university accredited by a regional, national, or specialized agency recognized as an accrediting agency by the U.S. Department of Education/U.S. Secretary of Education. If your degree or credits were awarded by an educational institution outside the United States and its territories, you must provide independent verification of equivalency.
