VACANCY ANNOUNCEMENT

ORANGE COUNTY DEPARTMENT OF FINANCE SENIOR ACCOUNTANT GRADE 17

The Orange County Department of Finance is now accepting applications to fill the position of Senior Accountant. This position is allocated to the competitive class. The nature of the appointment is provisional, pending the outcome of a Civil Service Examination. Civil Service Examination will be announced at a later date. The work involves responsibility for planning, directing and supervising a comprehensive system of municipal accounts. An incumbent in this position is responsible for providing technical accounting expertise and advice to the various county departments related to the financial and budgetary implications of specific accounting applications. The work is performed under the general supervision of the Fiscal Directors or Commissioner or Deputy Commissioners of Finance with wide latitude for independent judgement. General supervision is exercised over the work of Accountants and their respective staffs. Does related work as required.

MINIMUM QUALIFICATIONS: Possession of a Bachelor's degree in Accounting and five (5) years of professional accounting experience, two (2) years of which must have been in municipal accounting, or five (5) years of municipal auditing experience.

NOTES:

- Certification as a Public Accountant by the State of New York may be substituted for two (2) years of professional accounting experience.
- Possession of a Master's degree in Accounting, Business Administration, Public Administration or closely related field may be substituted for one (1) year of professional accounting experience.
- Your degree must have been awarded by a college or university accredited by a regional, national, or specialized agency recognized as an accrediting agency by the U.S. Department of Education/U.S. Secretary of Education. If your degree was awarded by an educational institution outside the United States and its territories, you must provide independent verification of equivalency.
