The Orange County Department of Public Works is now accepting applications for an appointment to the position of Principal Engineer. Civil Service Examination is a requirement for appointment to become permanent. Competitive Examination to be announced at a later date.

The work involves responsibility for the administration of complex County highway engineering projects involving Civil Engineering design, construction and inspections. Work is performed under the direction of the Deputy Commissioner in accordance with established policies and regulations, with wide latitude for independent judgment. Supervision is exercised over assigned engineering staff. Does related work as required.

MINIMUM QUALIFICATIONS: Possession of a New York State Professional Engineer license and two (2) years of experience in the supervision of major engineering projects.

SPECIAL REQUIREMENT: Must possess and maintain a valid driver's license.

STARTING SALARY: \$49.1042/hour; \$89,369.64 annually (35 hours per week); annual performance adjustments until step 5. Eligibility for these increments is based on satisfactory service and completion of 52 weeks of paid service in the same grade (after third year of employment, salary will exceed \$105,000 annually)
