The Orange County Department of Public Works is now accepting applications for <u>three (3)</u> Heavy Motor Equipment Operator positions.

These positions will be assigned to the Highway Division. The work involves responsibility for the safe and efficient operation of various types of heavy motor equipment and for a variety of unskilled labor tasks. This class is distinguished from that of Motor Equipment Operator I and II in that there is greater responsibility for operating care and employees must have specific knowledge of the operation of the equipment. The work is performed under general supervision. Supervision may be exercised over the activities of others. Does related work as required.

### MINIMUM QUALIFICATIONS: Either:

- (A) Graduation from high school or possession of a high school equivalency diploma and two (2) years of experience that shall have included the operation of heavy motor equipment; OR
- (B) Three (3) years of work experience as defined in (A) above.

### **SPECIAL REQUIREMENT:**

Must possess and maintain a valid Commercial Driver's License with a "B" classification (CDL-B).

**SALARY**: Orange County employees as per contract; For new employees: \$23.1147 per hour; \$42,068.75 annually (35 hours/week)
