Resumes are being accepted for the position of Deputy Commissioner of Public Works – Division of Engineering. The Deputy Commissioner serves as the Director of the Division of Engineering and oversees and participates as the leading member of the Department's construction and design teams, providing technical input with the development of new construction designs and advising in regard to their eventual field application. The Deputy is also responsible for the supervision of the Department's Highway Maintenance Division. The Deputy must possess professional engineering knowledge, skills and abilities. The Deputy is appointed by and serves at the pleasure of the Commissioner.

MINIMUM QUALIFICATIONS: Possession of a New York State Professional Engineer's license and any combination of training and experience deemed acceptable to the Commissioner of Public Works.

Suggested Standards: Bachelor's degree and eight (8) years experience in engineering activities, two (2) years of which must have been in an administrative capacity.
