Per Diem employees are assigned to work on an as-needed basis to fulfill weekend, holiday, or shift assignments. Employment will not exceed 19 hours per week.

The work involves responsibility for the supervision of the nursing care function, related resources and the development, implementation and evaluation of the nursing regimen for residents of the Orange County Residential Health Care Facility. This is a responsible supervisory position wherein incumbents evaluate and monitor nursing personnel to assure delivery of the highest standards of nursing services to the residents of the facility.

MINIMUM QUALIFICATIONS: Possession of a valid license and current registration* issued by the New York State Education Department as a Registered Professional Nurse, and either

- (A) Three (3) years of licensed nursing experience, one (1) year of which shall have included supervising the work of certified, licensed or registered nursing personnel; OR
- (B) Bachelor's Degree or higher in Nursing and two (2) years of experience in licensed nursing activities, one (1) year of which shall have included supervising the work of certified, licensed or registered nursing personnel.
- Completion of one-year traineeship in the title of Nursing Care Supervisor. (C)

SPECIAL REQUIREMENT: *Must maintain registration in good standing in order to remain in position.
