The Assistant Director of Systems Integration is responsible for the network administration and security for all County systems and for the installation and maintenance of County databases. Develops system configurations and selects software, hardware and databases to meet County needs. In addition, the incumbent is responsible for the efficient functioning of network and telecommunications systems. The work is performed under general direction of the Director of Systems Integration and direct supervision is exercised over the technical resource personnel. Incumbent may be required to work evenings and weekends.

MINIMUM QUALIFICATIONS: Either:

- (A) Bachelor's Degree, or higher, in Computer Science or related field and two (2) years experience as a local and wide area network administrator, one (1) year of which must have been in a supervisory position; OR
- (B) Associate's Degree in Computer Science or related field and four (4) years of experience as defined in (A) above, one (1) year of which must have been in a supervisory position; OR
- (C) Possession of a Microsoft Certification and three (3) years of experience as defined in (A) above, one (1) year of which must have been in a supervisory position; OR
- (D) Graduation from high school or possession of a high school equivalency diploma and six (6) years experience as defined in (A) above, one (1) year of which must have been in a supervisory position.
