- 3. Assists in arranging for specialized training programs conducted by Vendor Consultants or State certified instructors;
- 4. Enforces adherence to the Center's safety rules and regulations;
- 5. Oversees and participates in the maintenance of Center equipment including, but not limited to, fire trucks and tank cars;
- 6. Maintains records for all fire companies participating in training programs at the Center;
- 7. Maintains training supply inventory and orders supplies;
- 8. Prepares reports as required.

## FULL PERFORMANCE KNOWLEDGES, SKILLS, ABILITIES AND PERSONAL CHARACTERISTICS:

Good knowledge of modern fire fighting and fire prevention methods; ability to establish and maintain good working relationships; ability to plan and coordinate training programs; ability to communicate both orally and in writing; working knowledge of budgetary and purchasing practices; physical condition commensurate with the demands of the position.
