- 3. Troubleshoots electrical problems on motors, motor starters, generators, switch gears, compressors;
- 4. Replaces broken or damaged breakers on live panel boxes;
- 5. Runs and/or installs electric service to new work areas throughout the campus;
- 6. Repairs any and all electrical equipment such as electric staple machines, copiers, dark room equipment; electric tools;
- 7. Installs outdoor lighting for buildings;
- 8. Contacts outside vendors to order and purchase necessary supplies;
- 9. Performs pool related duties as required;
- 10. Assists Senior Building Maintenance Mechanic in troubleshooting mechanical systems of the building;
- 11. Assists with snow removal;
- 12. May be required to maintain daily log of work performed.

FULL PERFORMANCE KNOWLEDGES, SKILLS, ABILITIES AND PERSONAL
