- 4. Arranges for all work including inspections, collision and transmission repairs and alignment;
- 5. Maintains vehicle repair records and furnishes data for annual tradeins;
- 6. Oversees operation of parts department including billings, invoices and parts charge-outs;
- 7. Uses two-way radio to dispatch assistance to disabled motor pool vehicles;
- Coordinates vehicle impounding procedures with District Attorney's Office;
- 9. Prepares purchase orders for shop manuals. equipment and supplies.

10. Oversees computer operations in Central Motor Pool area.
