- 7. Follows safety instructions in the lifting, pushing, transferring and use of food, equipment and cleaning supplies;
- May assist with the preparation and cooking of a variety of foods and beverages such as sandwiches, soups, vegetables, salads, or coffee using proper safety precautions and sanitary measures;

- 9. When assigned to Office for the Aging, assists with packing food items for home-delivered meals;
- 10. When assigned to Office for the Aging, assists with all necessary duties in the absence of the Cook I and/or Assistant Cook I;
- 11. When assigned to Office for the Aging, may transport food/supplies via County vehicle for Senior Dining Program.
