**DISTINGUISHING FEATURES OF THE CLASS:** The work involves responsibility for safe and efficient operation of a tractor, dump or other type truck plus other moderately complex motor equipment and for performing a variety of manual tasks. The class differs from that of MEO I in the increased complexity of the equipment operated, and a greater degree of independent assignments given. Work is performed under general supervision of a designated supervisor. Does related work as required.

### **TYPICAL WORK ACTIVITIES:**

1. Operates a tractor, dump or cargo type truck, or other automotive equipment in connection with mowing, snow removal, spreading salt and sand, and/or the hauling of various items such as stone, gravel, plant mix asphalt and other materials and supplies;
2. Checks equipment for fuel, oil, and general condition prior to operation;
3. Maintains assigned vehicle in clean condition;
4. Performs manual labor such as material handling, flagging, brushcutting, weedwacking, and other related activities;
5. May supervise and work alongside a small group of subordinate employees on specific assignments;
6. May operate heavy motor equipment on a relief or trainee basis with proper licensure.

**FULL PERFORMANCE KNOWLEDGES, SKILLS, ABILITIES AND PERSONAL**

**CHARACTERISTICS:** Good knowledge of the operation of trucks, ability to understand and follow simple oral and written directions; mechanical aptitude; industriousness; dependability; physical condition commensurate with the demands of the position.

**MINIMUM QUALIFICATIONS:** Two (2) years of experience that shall have included the operation of some type of truck or other automotive equipment.

**SPECIAL REQUIREMENTS:**

When assigned to the Department of Public Works Highway Division, must possess and maintain a valid Commercial Driver's License with a "B" classification (CDL-B) within one year of appointment. For other assignments, must possess and maintain a valid driver's license.
