TYPICAL WORK ACTIVITIES:

- Prepares residents for treatment and transports or accompanies them to treatment areas;
- 2. Assists residents in activities of maintenance programs as assigned by Occupational Therapist or Occupational Therapy Assistant;
- 3. Assists residents in carrying out their maintenance programs;
- 4. Assists the therapist in helping residents with exercise movements or in changing positions during treatment;
- 5. Assists the therapist in helping residents with restorative, rehabilitative and occupational therapy treatments;
- 6. Maintains daily schedule of residents' appointments and makes appropriate changes as directed;

- 7. Maintains a current list of adaptive equipment and assignment of same to residents;
- 8. Cleans and makes simple repairs to equipment used in occupational therapy treatments;
- 9. Keeps daily attendance of residents at clinics and prepares monthly report;
- Maintains inventory of all supplies and equipment used in performance of functional and maintenance activities in clinics and alerts Occupational Therapy Assistant of pending shortages;
- 11. Cleans equipment after use in clinics and tidies up working areas;
- 12. Assists with residents' feeding program assuring residents are supplied with necessary equipment;
- 13. Participates in feeding residents as needed.

CHARACTERISTICS: Working knowledge of the principles, objectives, and techniques of occupational therapy treatments; knowledge of the operation, care and storage of apparatus and equipment used in the occupational therapy program; ability to understand written and oral instructions; ability to relate to geriatric residents who have serious physical problems; ability to motivate and encourage residents to continue with maintenance regimes; emotional maturity; patience; tact; physical condition commensurate with the demands of the position.
