DISTINGUISHING FEATURES OF THE CLASS:

This work involves the professional nursing care of patients in accordance with established policies and procedures. Nursing care including adult health, occupational health and chest clinic activities, is provided to individuals and their families under the direction of a qualified physician and in accordance with the current accepted standards of nursing practice. Work is performed under the general supervision of a Supervising Public Health Nurse. May be required to work shifts and/or weekends. Does related work as required.

TYPICAL WORK ACTIVITIES:

- 1. Interviews persons reported as infected or exposed to communicable diseases;
- 2. Staffs and generally assists physician in clinics (immunization, pediatric, STD, chest and various other);
- 3. Conducts investigations on contacts named by patients for prevention and control of communicable diseases;
- 4. Refers patients and families to other community agencies;
- 5. Prepares nursing records and reports;
- 6. Coordinates patient services with other disciplines;
- 7. Supervises the work of Home Health Aides when assigned to the same work site;
- 8. Enters case activity into records system using a computer and retrieves information as needed.
