Direct supervision is exercised over ski patrol volunteers. Does related work as required.

TYPICAL WORK ACTIVITIES:

- 1. Recruits and directs the volunteer ski patrol;
- 2. Inspects lifts and coordinates operating procedures daily;
- Inspects snow conditions and alerts Park personnel of hazardous locations;
- 4. Polices slope for violations of safety rules and Park regulations;
- 5. Assists in operational activities, such as operating ski lift, crowd control, establishing walking lanes in winter activities areas, snow grooming and loading snow tubes as required;

- 6. Administers first aid to injured persons;
- 7. Makes and files accident reports concerning all injuries;
- 8. Maintains first aid room and equipment;
- 9. Submits requisitions for materials and supplies and keeps records of all ski patrol activities.
