CLASS TITLE: ASSISTANT PUBLIC WORKS SUPERVISOR

DISTINGUISHING FEATURES OF THE CLASS: The work involves responsibility for a variety of public work activities including assumption of supervisory responsibilities. Work is performed under general supervision with leeway for independent judgment in routine assignments. Does related work as required.

TYPICAL WORK ACTIVITIES:

Operates a motor vehicle in connection with snow removal, or the transportation of stone, gravel or other supplies and equipment;

Operates a tractor/truck with trailer, snow blower, bulldozer, concrete mixer, stone crusher, or other attached equipment;

Performs manual labor such as loading, unloading, digging and related activities;

Supervises and participates in the maintenance of road equipment;

Supervises the work of road crew in the absence of the designated supervisor.

When assigned to the Village of Florida:

May perform water plant treatment operator duties, on an as needed basis, with possession of the appropriate certification issued under the provisions of the New York State Sanitary Code.

FULL PERFORMANCE KNOWLEDGES, SKILLS, ABILITIES AND PERSONAL CHARACTERISTICS:

Good knowledge of the operation and maintenance of a variety of motor equipment; working knowledge of road construction and maintenance work; ability to supervise the work of others; ability to follow oral and written instructions; ability to keep records and make reports; mechanical aptitude; dependability; physical condition commensurate with the demands of the position.

MINIMUM QUALIFICATIONS: Either:

- (A) Graduation from high school or possession of a high school equivalency diploma and two (2) years experience in Public Works activities; OR
- (B) Six (6) years experience in Public Works activities.

SPECIAL REQUIREMENT: Possess and maintain a valid driver's license in a class appropriate to the requirements of the Appointing Authority.

NOTE: When assigned to the Village of Florida, may be required to possess a Grade D certification issued under the provisions of the New York Sanitary Code.

JURISDICTIONAL CLASS: Non-Competitive in Towns and Villages.
