CLASS TITLE: POOL MAINTENANCE OPERATOR

TITLE #: 1479

DISTINGUISHING FEATURES OF THE CLASS: This work involves responsibility for the daily maintenance of the swimming pool in a school, including maintaining chemical levels, inspection of pool equipment, and inspection of safety equipment. The incumbent is also responsible for assuring sanitary conditions are met in the areas adjacent to the pool such as offices, showers and restrooms. Work is performed under the general supervision of the Superintendent of Buildings and Grounds. Does related work as required.

TYPICAL WORK ACTIVITIES:

Tests and maintains chemical levels in pool;

Vacuums and maintains pool and filtration equipment;

Checks pool temperature;

Performs daily inspections of drains, ladders, gates, water clarity, chemical containers, storage of chemicals and filter building;

Mops and disinfects all floors in offices, toilets and showers and cleans gutters, handrails and tile around pool;

Orders, receives and stores pool chemicals;

Performs miscellaneous duties and errands as directed by the Supervisor of Buildings and Grounds.

FULL PERFORMANCE KNOWLEDGES, SKILLS, ABILITIES AND PERSONAL CHARACTERISTICS: Good knowledge of the proper handling and storage of potentially hazardous chemicals; working knowledge of swimming pool maintenance; ability to communicate with faculty and staff; ability to perform routine manual work; good judgment; physical condition commensurate with the demands of the position.

MINIMUM QUALIFICATIONS: Possession of a certification as a pool operator a mandated by the New York Sanitary Code, Section 6 - 1.21(b).

JURSIDICTIONAL CLASSIFICATION: Non-competitive among School Districts.
