CLASS TITLE: SENIOR MOTOR EQUIPMENT OPERATOR

TITLE #: 1596

DISTINGUISHING FEATURES OF THE CLASS: The work involves responsibility for safe and efficient operation of a single axle truck plus other moderately complex motor equipment and for performing a variety of manual tasks. The class differs from that of Motor Equipment Operator in the increased complexity of the equipment operated, and a greater degree of independent assignments given. Work is performed under general supervision of a designated supervisor. Does related work as required.

TYPICAL WORK ACTIVITIES:

Operates a single axle dump or cargo type truck or other motor equipment in connection with snow removal, spreading salt, sand and mowing and/or hauling of various items such as stone, gravel, materials plants mix asphalt and other materials and supplies;

Checks equipment for fuel, oil, and general condition prior to operation;

Maintains assigned vehicle in clean condition;

Performs manual labor such as material handling and helping grounds and road maintenance crews;

May supervise a small group of laborers on specific assignments.

FULL PERFORMANCE KNOWLEDGES, SKILLS, ABILITIES AND PERSONAL

CHARACTERISTICS: Good knowledge of the operation of trucks; ability to understand and follow simple oral and written directions; mechanical aptitude; industriousness; dependability; physical condition commensurate with the demands of the position.

MINIMUM QUALIFICATIONS: One (1) one year of experience in the operation of some type of truck or motor equipment.

SPECIAL REQUIREMENTS: Possess and maintain a valid Commercial Driver's license in a class appropriate to the requirements of the Appointing Authority.

JURISDICTIONAL CLASSIFICATION: Non-Competitive among Towns & Villages.
