CLASS TITLE: STREET CROSSING GUARD

DISTINGUISHING FEATURES OF THE CLASS: This work involves responsibility for assisting children and other pedestrians in the safe crossing of streets and intersections and/or the direction of traffic at school and church crossings during specified periods of time. The work is performed under the direct supervision of a senior official. Does related work as required.

TYPICAL WORK ACTIVITIES:

Directs children and other pedestrians in safely crossing streets and intersections;

Instructs pedestrians on proper street crossing and general traffic procedures;

Monitors all traffic activities for a specified area;

Maintains order at crossings and intersections;

Provides information on traffic and street conditions;

May direct traffic as required;

May be required to complete or assist in completing department documents or records;

May report specific traffic safety problems or incidents to proper authorities.

FULL PERFORMANCE KNOWLEDGE, SKILLS, ABILITIES AND PERSONAL CHARACTERISTICS:

Good general intelligence; ability to understand and follow oral and written instructions; ability to communicate clearly and effectively; ability to work under adverse conditions; ability to get along with others; visual acuity; good powers of observation and judgment; physical condition commensurate with the demands of the position.
